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Dear Parents

Happy New Year!!!

I hope you all had a good Christmas and that everyone is fighting fit after so much illness running up to the end of term. In order to avoid the spread of infection, we ask that you keep your child at home if they are running a temperature or if they have had sickness, children must not return to Nursery for 48 hours after they were last sick.

If your child is eligible for funding you will need to complete and sign the yellow 'free entitlement declaration form' which you should have received. Please ensure that we hold a copy of your child's birth certificate as we cannot access your funding unless we hold these documents.

Our topic this term is 'Journeys' and our teacher led art sessions will focus on numbers and shapes. We will also continue to write up the white board which will be displayed outside each day, detailing all the activities the children have been involved in that day. This then gives you the opportunity to talk to your child at home about their day.

Please can we also request that all lunch boxes and drinks bottles are clearly named, so that they can be reunited with their owner at lunch time! It avoids upset and confusion. Could we also ask if you are putting grapes into lunch boxes that they be cut in half. This is a recommendation from a recently attended first aid course; we have been advised that grapes are the most common choking hazard in young children.

Those children in the **Tiger and Elephant groups** will also need a PE kit for our more formal PE sessions each week, a pair of shorts, T-shirt (in any colour or design) and plimsolls, named in a draw string bag, which will be kept at the Nursery school.

Madame Wilson will return to the Nursery on Monday 12th January to continue with our French sessions, we will continue to learn French songs and rhymes and counting to 5.

Please check the notice board in the lobby for information related to this term timetable, key worker groups and term dates. We will be sending home each child's profile at the end of this term, but if you want to discuss anything relating to your child, please grab us at the start or end of a session, we are happy to discuss things with you at anytime.
